Supervisor Election

The Ohio Soil and Water Conservation Commission will cause an election of Supervisors of the Wyandot Soil and Water Conservation District to be held in accordance with Chapter 940 of the Ohio Revised Code. Individuals who own or occupy land within Wyandot County and are 18 years of age or older may vote for Supervisor.

The 30-day voting period begins July 17 and ends with voting at the banquet on August 15.

SWCD supervisors are elected by county residents and landowners to represent them in soil and water conservation and natural resources management decisions. Two (2) supervisors will be elected for a term beginning January 1, 2024, and ending December 31, 2026.

There are three ways an eligible voter can cast a ballot:

1. At the SWCD office Monday - Friday during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. beginning July 17 until August 15.
2. At the SWCD annual meeting at Trinity Evangelical Church, 108 Malabar Drive, Upper Sandusky, on **Tuesday, August 15, 2023, from 5:45 p.m. until 6:45 p.m.**
3. By requesting the application and election ballot by mail from the SWCD office at 97 Houpt Drive, Suite A, Upper Sandusky, OH 43351, by calling (419) 731-2557 or by e-mailing eileen.kuenzli@oh.nacdnet.net. Absentee ballots must be received by the SWCD office by 4:00 p.m. August 15, 2023.

At the annual meeting, you may vote before the meal without purchasing a meal ticket.

Meal tickets can be purchased at the SWCD office.
