LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in the southeast quarter of Section 4, Mifflin Township, Town-3-South, Range-13-East, Wyandot County, Ohio described as follows:

Commencing at a found railroad spike marking the southeast corner of said section and the centerline of State Route 53: thence N 90° 00' 00" W three hundred sixty-nine and forty hundredths (369.40) feet along the southerly line of said section and the centerline of State Route 53 to a set P-K nail. THE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence N 90° 00' 00" W two hundred eighty-three and zero hundredths (283.00) feet along the southerly line of said section and said centerline to a set P-K nail;

thence N 00° 35' 00" E three hundred ninety and zero hundredths (390.00) feet to a set iron rod, passing at twenty-two and fifty hundredths (22.50) feet a set iron rod on the northerly right-of-way of said road;

thence S 89° 57' 43" E two hundred sixty-six and sixty-one hundredths (266.61) feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 01° 49' 30" E three hundred ninety and zero hundredths (390.00) feet to THE POINT OF BEGINNING, passing at three hundred sixty-seven and forty-nine hundredths (367.49) feet a set iron rod on the northerly right-of-way of said road.

Containing in all, 2.460 acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

Bearings are assumed and for angular measurement only.
