### LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR: Dorothy Shoemaker Estate


1.308 Acres

Situated in Richland Township, Wyandot County, State of Ohio, and being a part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5, T 2 S, R 12 E, a tract of land bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set on the north line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 5, and described as lying, S 90°00'00" W, a distance of 1,824.00 feet from a stone found marking the northeast corner of said Section 5; thence from the above described point of beginning, S 01°34'00" E, a distance of 324.00 feet to an iron stake set, and passing an iron stake set at 25.00 feet; thence parallel with the north line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 5, S 90°00'00" W, a distance of 151.75 feet to an iron stake set; thence N 10°00'00" W, a distance of 328.88 feet to a railroad spike set on the north line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 5, and passing an iron stake set 25.38 feet south thereof; thence along the north line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 5, also being the centerline of County Road Number 4, N 90°00'00" E, a distance of 200.00 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 1.308 acres of land, more or less, subject however to all legal highways and prior easements of record.
