LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in the southwest quarter of Section 2, Ridge Township, Town-1-South, Range-12-East, Wyandot County, Ohio, described as follows:

Commencing at a found railroad spike marking the intersection of the centerline of Township Highway 89 and the East-West quarter (1/4) section line of said section; thence S 00° 00' 00" W one thousand seventy-three and thirty-four hundredths (1073.34) feet along the centerline of said highway to a set P-K nail. **THE POINT OF BEGINNING:**

thence S 00° 00' 00" W four hundred seven and fifty-four hundredths (407.54) feet along said centerline to a set P-K nail;

thence S 88° 25' 39" W eight hundred sixteen and eighty-six hundredths (816.86) feet to a found concrete fence post, passing a set iron rod on the westerly right-of-way of said road;

thence N 00° 16' 56" W four hundred ninety-two and fifty-one hundredths (492.51) feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 85° 37' 58" E eight hundred twenty-one and thirty-six hundredths (821.36) feet to **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**, passing a set iron rod on the westerly right-of-way of said road.

Containing in all, 8.448 acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

Bearings are assumed and for angular measurement only.
