Being part of the South Half of Van Buren Street in the Unincorporated Village of Little Sandusky, Pitt Township, Wyandot County, State of Ohio; and being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a 5/8" dia. iron pin set at the intersection of the West Right-of-Way Line of Madison Street (now being 50 feet wide) with the South Right-of-way Line of Van Buren Street (now being 50 feet wide) (also being the North Line of Lot 69);

Thence along said South Right-of-Way Line S 56° 22' 40" W (basis of bearing, assumed) for a distance of 200.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin set on the East Right-of-Way Line of Monroe Street (now being 50 feet wide);

Thence along said East Right-of-Way Line N 33° 37' 20" W for a distance of 25.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin set;

Thence N 56° 22' 40" E for a distance of 200.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin set on the West Right-of-Way Line of Madison Street;

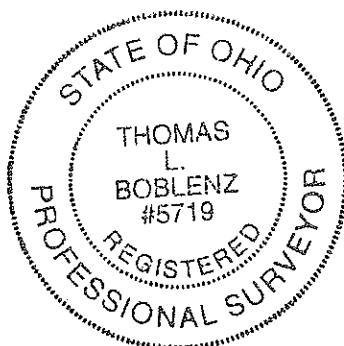
Thence along said West Right-of-Way Line S 33° 37' 20" E for a distance of 25.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin set on the South Right-of-Way Line of Van Buren Street and the point of beginning.

Beginning at an existing iron pin located at the intersection of the North Right-of-way Line of Van Buren Street (now being 50 feet wide) (also being the South Line of Lot 68) with the West Right-of-Way Line of Madison Street (now being 50 feet wide);

Thence along said West Right-of-Way Line S 33° 37' 20" E (basis of bearing, assumed) for a distance of 25.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin set;

Thence S 56° 22' 40" W for a distance of 200.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin set on the East Right-of-Way Line of Monroe Street (now being 50 feet wide);

Thence along said East Right-of-Way Line N 33° 37' 20" W for a distance of 25.00 feet to an existing iron pin on the North Right-of-Way Line of Van Buren Street;

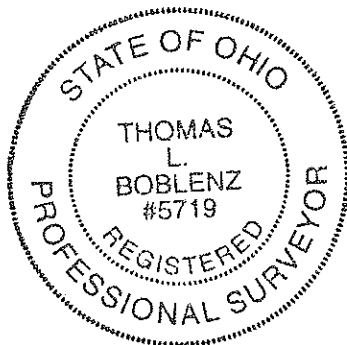
