

SUPERVISOR ELECTION

The Ohio Soil and Water Conservation Commission will cause an election of Supervisors of the Wyandot Soil and Water Conservation District to be held in accordance with Chapter 940 of the Ohio Revised Code. Individuals who own or occupy land within Wyandot County and are 18 years of age or older may vote for Supervisor.

The 30-day voting period begins August 20, 2024 and ends on September 18, 2024.

SWCD supervisors are elected by county residents and landowners to represent them in soil and water conservation and natural resource management decisions. One (1) supervisor will be elected for a term beginning January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2027. Ryan Swinehart is running unopposed.


There are three ways an eligible voter can cast a ballot:

1. At the SWCD office Monday—Friday during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. beginning August 20, 2024 until September 18, 2024.
2. At the SWCD annual meeting at Trinity Evangelical Church, 108 Malabar Drive, Upper Sandusky, on Tuesday, August 20, 2024 from 5:45 until 6:45 p.m.
3. By requesting the application and election ballot by mail from the SWCD office at 97 Houpt Drive, Suite A, Upper Sandusky, OH 43351, by calling (419)731-2557 or by e-mailing eileen.kuenzli@oh.nacdnet.net. Absentee ballots must be received by the SWCD office by 4:00 p.m. on September 18, 2024.

At the annual meeting, you may vote before the meal without purchasing a meal ticket.

Meal tickets can be purchased at the SWCD office.

The caterer needs a count prior to the banquet, so please purchase your tickets by August 9.


Katie Rumschlag

H2Ohio Program Update


In 2024, there are six Wyandot County producers that have joined the H2Ohio program, enrolling over 4,000 more acres.

In Wyandot County, nine producers enrolled existing hay buffers that were adjacent to a ditch, stream, or river in the 2-year H2Ohio Working Lands Buffer Program, with eleven contracts totaling 51.47 acres.

The new H2Ohio Working Lands Buffer Program provides a buffer to filter surface water before it enters into streams and other water sources that contribute to nutrient runoff to Lake Erie. Harvesting the buffer area is encouraged.

During the first half of 2024, Wyandot County producers were paid a total of \$225,312.03 for implementing practices in the H2Ohio program listed below:

Conservation Crop Rotation Small Grains	\$75,029.13
Overwintering Cover Crops	\$69,371.25
Subsurface Phosphorus Placement	\$38,275.00
Manure Incorporation	\$24,348.00
Voluntary Nutrient Management Plan Implementation	\$11,483.10
Early Seeding Bonus	\$ 2,993.60
Conservation Crop Rotation Forages	\$ 2,679.95
Variable Rate Phosphorus Application	\$ 1,132.00




