thence N 69° 15' 00" E a distance of 200.00 feet to a point, referenced by a set iron rod located S 01° 42' 00" E a distance of 1.00 foot;

thence S 01° 42' 00" E a distance of 290.00 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, passing two set iron rods a distance of 1.00 foot and 273.50 feet respectively.
