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**LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF A 0.129 ACRE PARCEL

thence on an assumed bearing of N 10° 27' 55" W along the centerline of County Highway 119 a distance of 1253.20 feet to a found railroad spike marking the northwest corner of a parcel of land currently owned by V. & C. Morral and being the **POINT OF BEGINNING**;

thence N 87° 59' 50" E a distance of 430.96 feet to a found wood post, passing 2 set iron rods for reference a distance of 30.33 feet and 429.96 feet respectively;

thence S 10° 27' 55" E a distance of 26.28 feet to a set iron rod marking the northeast corner of said Morral parcel;

thence N 88° 34' 55" W along said Morral parcel a distance of 435.60 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing in all 0.129 acre of land, more or less, of which 0.000 acre, more or less, is currently contained within highway right-of-ways. The above described property being subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

All set iron rods are 5/8" diameter with personalized plastic caps.
