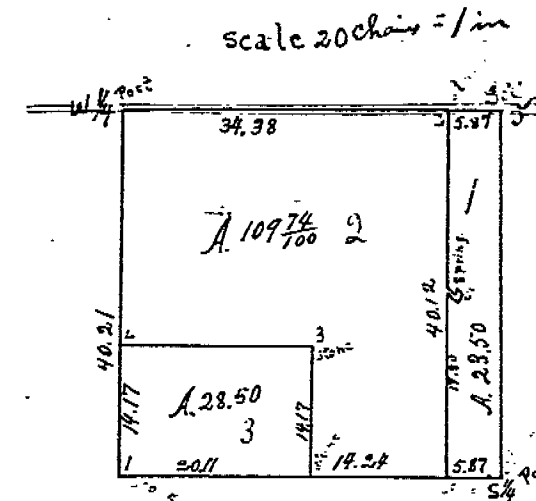

Survey of S.W. 1/4 Sec. 5 T. 4 S. R. 15 E.

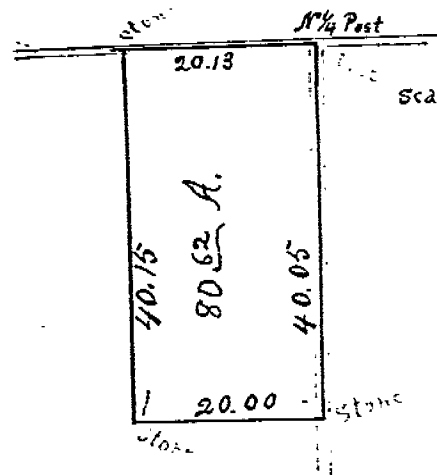

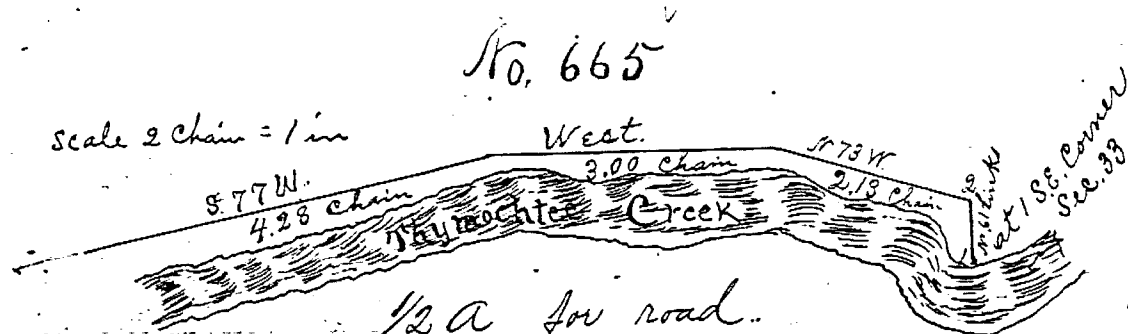
