Note

In the subdivision of this Township into sections the subdivision lines were projected Southward instead of Northward as should have been done. Thereby throwing the fractions to the north where the law provides they should be, and the rules requires it. It seems from the Government notes that the Deputy Surveyor discovered this error after making the subdivisions, and then wrote his notes in Reverse order so as to appear Correct.

Notes seem to show that the north and south subdivision lines invariably intersected the North Boundary "at the Post".

On account of the surplus being thrown to the south side of the Township and then Re-writing the notes so as to cause it to appear that the work was done in regular form.

There have been set a series of Corners at the north side of this surplus, making it appear that there is a strip of land lying between the two Townships and not returned in the Government Survey. While in reality, they mark the point to which the subdivision lines were run or produced Southward and then discontinued (So far as shown by notes). It is alleged at this time, that there is a so called "Vacant Strip" lying between Townships 2 & 3 South Range 12 East = But such does not exist it being the surplus in Township (2) south erroneously thrown to the south side of the Township & belonging wholly to that Township.
