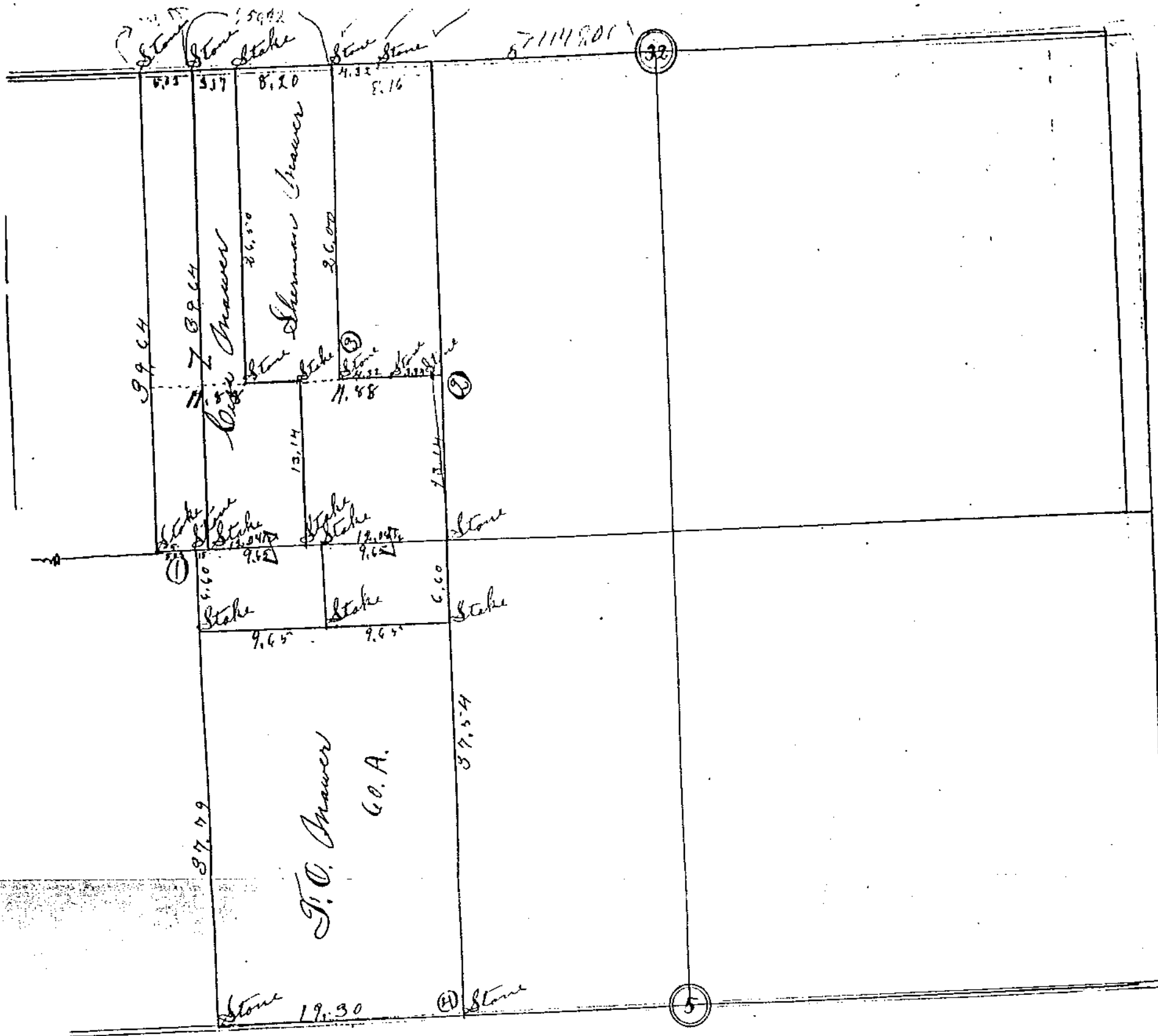

Survey of NW¹/₂ SW¹/₄ of Sec 32 T3S R14E, and NW¹/₂ of NW¹/₄ of Sec 5 T4S R14E, and SE¹/₄, E¹/₂ of SE¹/₄ of Sec 31 T3S of R14E.

At (1) Hickory 24" dia Bears S 17° W, 27 lks dist.

At (1) there is a stone to the corner of Sec 5 T4S and a stake to 31 P32,

" (3) Bur Oak 24" dia Bears N 1° E 75 links dist.

" (2) W. " 12" " " N 82° E 64 " "

There is something wrong at (2) but Mr John Mower and Sam Hughes agreed to recognize the stone that was.

At (3) Red Oak 12" dia Bears N 15° E 25 links dist.

" (3) Pin " 20" " " S 5° E 77 " "

At (4) Bur Oak 12" " " N 1 1/2° E 42 " "

" " Jack " 16" " " S 55° E 104 " "
