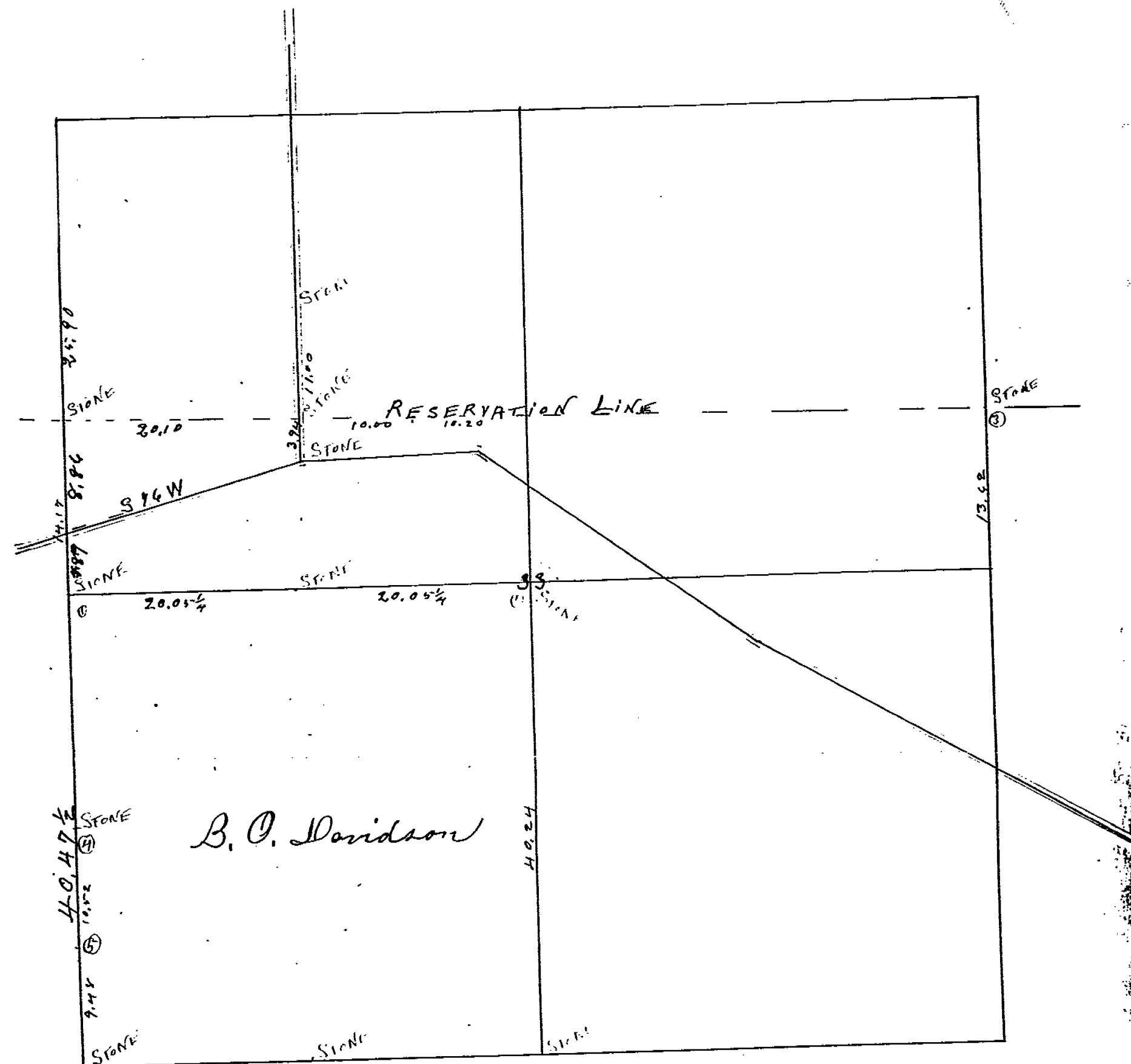

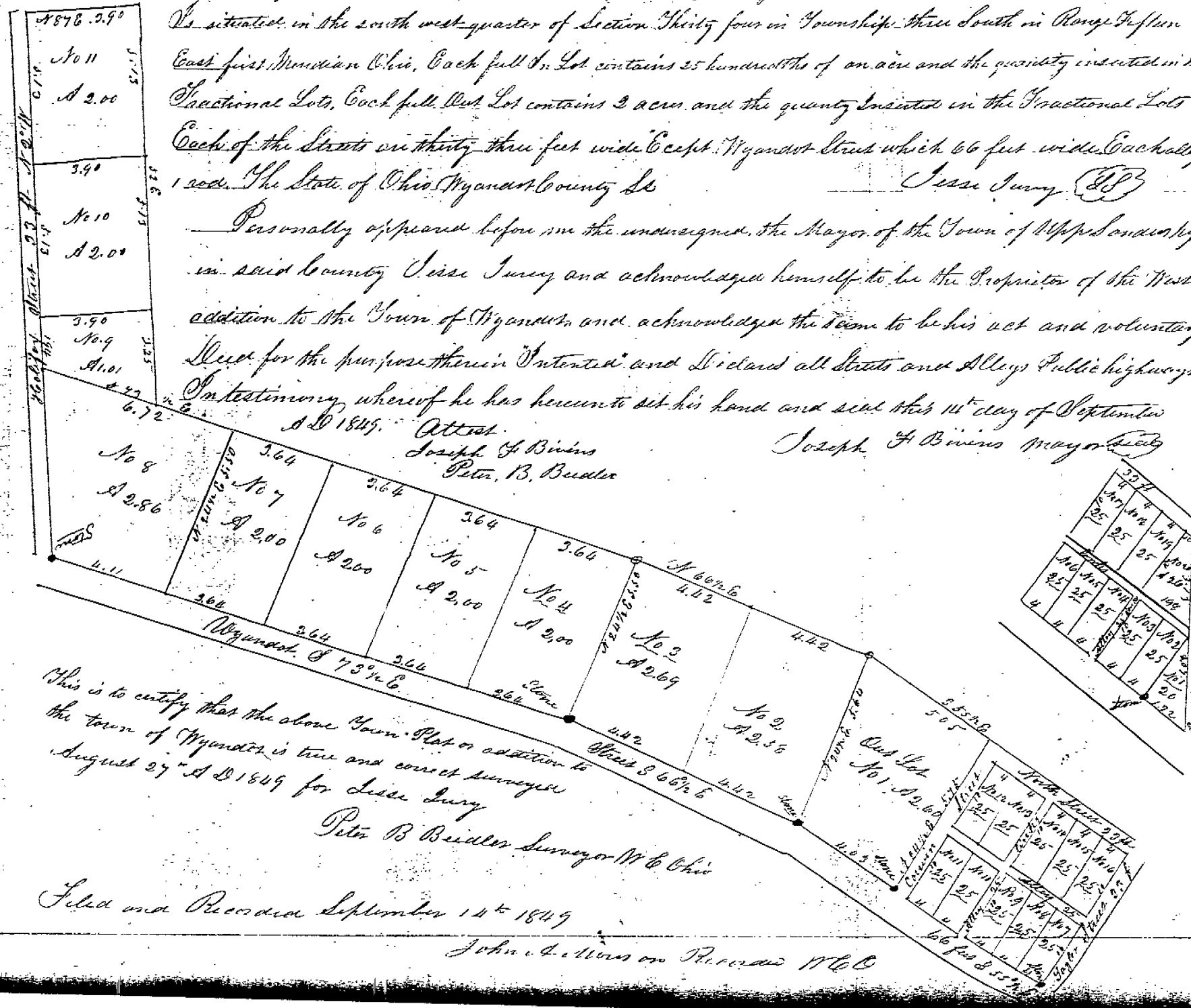
Map of the West Addition to the Town of Wyandot
