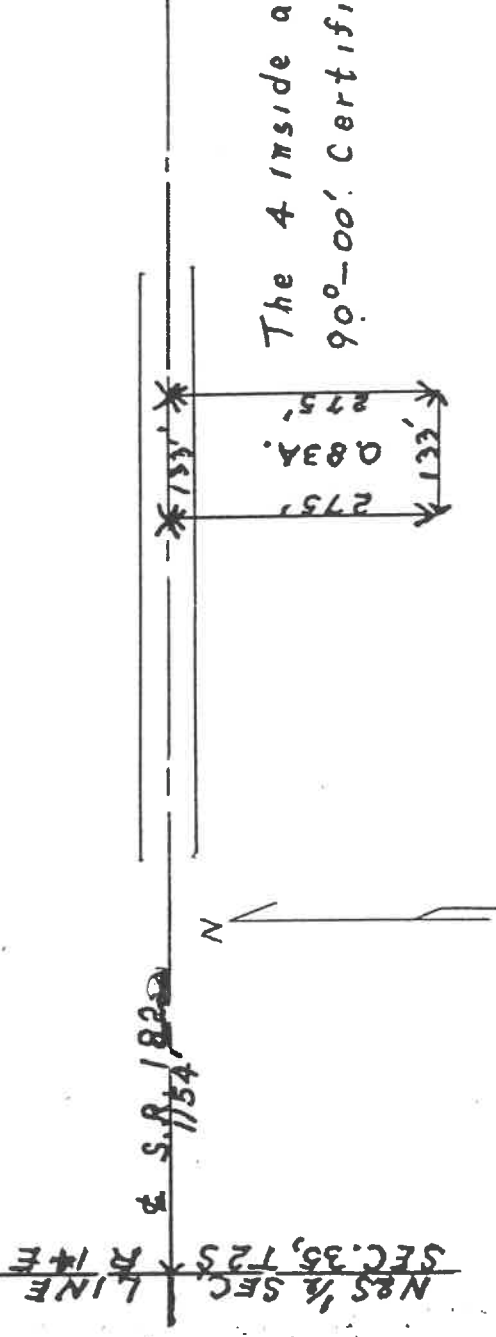


Survey No 796



The 4 inside angles of plot are
90°-00'. Certified true and Correct.

Being part of the North Part of the Southeast Quarter of Sec. 35, T2S, R14E in Crane Township, Wyandot County, Ohio and described as follows: from the intersection of the centerline of Ohio State Route No. 182 with the North and South one-half section line of the above said section No. 35, measure east along said Ohio State Route No. 182 centerline for 1154 feet, this being the point of beginning; thence continuing along said Ohio State Route No. 182 centerline for 133 feet to a point on last said centerline; thence south at an angle of 90 degrees for 275 feet to a point marked with an iron rod; thence west at an angle of 90 degrees for 133 feet to a point marked with an iron rod; thence north at an angle of 90 degrees for 275 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.83 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways.
