


LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR: Kenneth Meinzer Pt. SW1, Section 1, T2S, R13E, 1.5264 Acs.

Situated in Salem Township, County of Wyandot, State of Ohio and being a part of the SW1 of Section 1, T2S, R13E, a tract of land bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set on the south line of the SW1 of Section 1 and described as lying N 90°00'00" E, a distance of 417.66 feet from a monument box found set over a stone marking the southwest corner of said SW1; thence from the above described point of beginning, N 00°19'08" W, a distance of 264.21 feet to a 1/2" Rebar set and passing a 1/2" Rebar set at 25.00 feet; thence parallel with said south line of the SW1 of Section 1, N 90°00'00" E, a distance of 251.65 feet to a 1/2" Rebar set; thence S 00°19'08" E, a distance of 264.21 feet to a railroad spike set on said south line of the SW1 and passing a 1/2" Rebar set 25.00 feet north thereof; thence along said south line, also being the centerline of County Road No. 42, S 90°00'00" W, a distance of 251.65 feet to the point of beginning and containing 1.5264 Acres of land, more or less, subject however to all legal highways and prior encumbrances of record.
